















"The Nerd"



Footloose









What's it Mean?

Gauge = Widening the piercing by stages.

Monroe = A piercing above the top lip.

Tragus = Piercing the hard cartilage at the front/middle of the ear.

Microdermals (Surface) = Permanent piercings placed through the skin and into the tissue below.



David Kram shows off his gauged ear and his lip ring. His gauge is 1/2" wide and took around a year to achieve. "It doesn't hurt anymore," said Kram.




















































